How does State Employees Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards. We also do not share confidential or sensitive information.
How does State Employees Credit Union collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account or apply for a loan Show your driver's license or provide employment information Give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?
