FACTS

WHAT DOES STATE EMPLOYEES CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and Account Balances
- Payment History and Credit History
- Account Transactions and Transaction History or Loss History

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons State Employees Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

For our affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your transactions and experiences	No	We don't share

What we do

How does State Employees Credit Union protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards. We also do not share confidential or sensitive information.

How does State Employees Credit Union collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Open an account or apply for a loan
- Show your driver's license or provide employment information
- Give us your contact information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *State Employees Credit Union has no affiliates*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *State Employees Credit Union does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *State Employees Credit Union does not jointly market.*

Other important information

Do you Collect Information on My Children? Yes. However, we respect the privacy of children and do not collect any more information than necessary to enable them to participate in the activities we offer at our website. We do not allow other organizations to collect personal information from children and do not have any agreements with outside organizations to collect information at our site.

We collect the following information:

- E-mail addresses

Other important information (continued)

- Account Numbers
- Passwords
- Security Questions

The information that we collect from children is used:

- To access homebanking or e-statement services.

We will obtain parental consent before collecting information on your child, and you can review the information we have collected from your child online; prevent the further use or maintenance of that information, or direct the deletion of that information by notifying us:
